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"I stayed all five years in the series because I had agreed and signed from the beginning. I would never give up on a show that changed my life for the better. I have learned so much in these 5 years and have made life friends. I remember them with love and nostalgia. "

After *Charlie's Angels*, she was nominated for a Golden Globe for her performance as Jackie Kennedy.

"Showbiz is evolving at a galloping speed. Imagine that at the time we were playing television, we only had three channels here in the US. Now the choices are endless. My favorite series is *This is Us*. "

"Every woman is unique and must follow what her heart tells her. If you are a career woman go ahead without fear and remorse. Just be honest with yourself. For me, my family has always been a priority. "

But when did she discover the power of beauty?

"My wise mother used to say 'Pretty is as pretty does.' That is, it is more important to be nice than to be nice. So, we never really looked at my family as I grew up. "

"My mother wanted to be a fashion designer and she had an influence on me when I was young and I wanted to be myself too. So I designed the graduation dance for myself and that was just the beginning. For the past 35 years I have been lucky to have my own line of clothes with Sears and Kmart. "
