"I am so thrilled because this is another area for me. It's almost like people think of me coming back. But I'm not really coming back, I've been doing the same thing for years. This is the first time I'm doing something that everyone sees what I'm doing. Our fanbase of The Supremes, they know what I'm doing because they come to all the shows around the world, this and that. But here in LA and in the States, a lot of times they don't because I'm not on TV. It's really difficult for people to know what you're doing. So *Dancing With the Stars* for me is really huge."
